

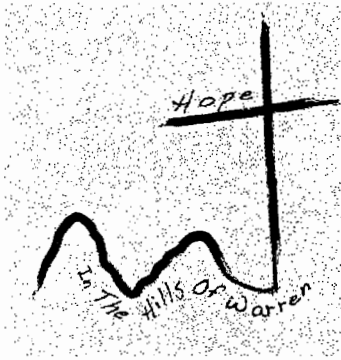
# Hope in the Hills of Warren

## Attention Homeowners

Are you elderly or disabled and/or low-income?

If you live in Washington Borough, Washington Township, Franklin Township, Mansfield Township or Oxford, you may be eligible to receive free home repair.



Hope in the Hills of Warren will be sponsoring a Weekend of Hope in 2017. Volunteer teams of workers will complete home repair projects for selected elderly, low-income, and or disabled families in need.

Each of our work teams are made up of teenagers and at least one adult leader. Our volunteers represent many Christian denominations and various community organizations. The labor and materials we provide are free to qualifying households.

Homeowners are expected to be at home while our work crews are present. Work will take place between 8:00 AM and 4:00 PM. **Only owner occupied homes in**

**Washington Borough, Washington Township, Franklin Township, Mansfield Township and Oxford will be considered.** Hope in the Hills of Warren is insured.

### Eligible repair projects may include:

- ✓ Porch / deck repair (minor)
- ✓ Step repair / handrails
- ✓ Exterior and interior painting
- ✓ Weatherization/caulking
- ✓ Small, light repair jobs
- ✓ Yard clean up (if done with a repair job)

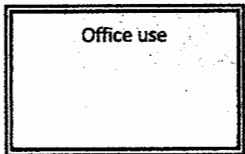

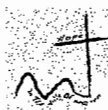

# "A Day of Help" – May 20, 2017

SPRING CLEAN-UP HELP FOR THE ELDERLY AND DISABLED



Hope in the Hills of Warren, a community extension of Warren County Habitat for Humanity, is sponsoring a new program this year called "A Day of Help". Volunteer teams of workers will be available to help with spring clean-up projects inside and/or outside the home.



A work team of teenagers and adults will perform 3 hours of work for elderly and disabled residents. Our volunteers represent many Christian denominations and various community organizations. The labor and materials we provide are free to qualifying households.

We are accepting applications from elderly or disabled residents of Washington Borough, Washington Township, Franklin Township, Mansfield Township or Oxford, until April 1, 2017.

## You may be eligible to receive free spring clean-up help.

Residents are expected to be at home while our work crews are present. Work will take place between 8:00 AM and 4:00 PM. Our crews will be assigned to go out to selected residences for either a 3-hour morning or 3-hour afternoon work shift. **Priority will be given to elderly or disabled residents who would otherwise find it difficult or impossible to have this work done.** Hope in the Hills of Warren is insured.

Possible projects could include:

- ✓ Window Washing
- ✓ Floor cleaning/Vacuuming
- ✓ Gardening
- ✓ Dusting
- ✓ Raking /Yard clean up
- ✓ Replacing smoke detector batteries
- ✓ Changing light bulbs
- ✓ Gutter cleaning

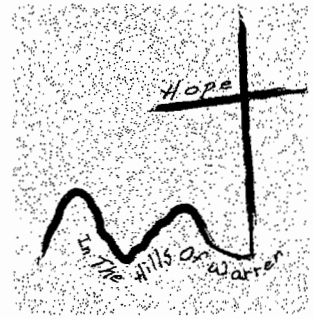

## Hope in the Hills of Warren -- 2017 Programs

In 2017, Hope in the Hills of Warren will be offering two opportunities for residents to receive help.



We are planning our "Weekend of Hope", for June 24-26, 2017, and "A Day of Help" for Saturday, May 20, 2017.

Both programs are available to residents of Franklin, Mansfield, Oxford, Washington Borough and Washington Township. The table below will help clarify some of the differences and similarities of the two programs and help you decide if you are able to apply for one or both. Type of help provided and timeframe for work	One 3-hour shift of spring clean-up, may be inside or outside.	Minor home repairs and painting. Work may span over more than one day.
Who is eligible?	Residents (homeowner/renter) of Franklin, Mansfield, Oxford, Washington Borough and Washington Township, age 70+ or disabled. Dwelling must be primary residence.	Homeowners of Franklin, Mansfield, Oxford, Washington Borough and Washington Township, age 70+, or disabled, or low income. Dwelling must be primary residence.
When will the work be done?	Saturday, May 20, 2017	Saturday, June 24 - Monday, June 26, 2017
Application deadline	No later than April 1, 2017	No later than April 1, 2017
Cost to resident	Free to qualifying residents	Free to qualifying residents

Please note that if you are a resident homeowner who is age 70 or older or disabled, you may apply for BOTH programs.
