#### NEW BUSINESS - Community Center

Mayor Toretta was informed of heavy usage activity in the community center over the past weekend, cars parked on the lawn and bathrooms left a mess. A concern as to the taxing on our septic system. We need to look at the cost of utilities and what is coming in from groups that rent out the facility annually, we cleared \$10,000 in 2021. Eddy Patient advised that this is the winter season with heavy basketball activities. It is more crowded during this time and participants overlap between each game. The occupancy limit has not been exceeded. FTYA and Franklin Residents are not charged to rent the facility however, outside groups pay full price. We need to further review our guidelines, rental fee costs and utility costs and group capacities and our septic system, to see if we might need to adjust the activity for future rentals.

#### Engineer –

Donna Becker informed the Millbrook Road Project is moving forward, and the survey is almost completed. Montana Road Project, the excavator is waiting for the ground to dry out to start the work. The Dioxane Project estimate has been submitted to the NJDEP and waiting for approval on their end. We still need committee approval for the NRCS Project (Shurts Road) and only have a 220-day timeframe for work to be completed.

Attorney Benbrook briefed the committee on the Tax Foreclosure and searches. As to the active Gupta Litigation the invoice received for approximately \$10,000 is due for retention fees and coinsurance amounts. Heisler Litigation has been completed. Livingston Litigation no fees to date have been submitted. Lighting/Invasive Species ordinances still searching sample ordinances. The township committee is required to complete harassment training and protecting minors as per new guidelines in our Policy/Procedure Manual. The Kober's Solar Project is on hold.
