Remember, batteries should never be put in your recycling cart, bucket or bin as they not only are contaminants in the recycling process, but certain rechargeable batteries - lithium batteries, in particular - may combust if damaged and so pose a threat to recycling facilities and staff. Learn about non-recyclable batteries that can be safely disposed in the trash, as well as rechargeable batteries that can be recycled at https://www.call2recycle.org/. Rechargeable batteries can be recycled at one of the 30,000 public and private Call2Recycle collection sites located throughout the United States and Canada.
